

## RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS:

The recycling bin and paper may be placed at the road for weekly collection.

Paper must be separated from containers.

## CONTAINERS

**HOUSEHOLD BOTTLES, CANS AND JARS**  
(Place mixed loose containers in the recycling – NO PLASTIC BAGS)

- **ALUMINUM CANS & CLEAN KITCHEN FOIL PRODUCTS**



- **STEEL/TIN CANS**

- ✓ Rinse clean of food.
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans.
- ✓ Labels need not be removed.
- ✓ **NO** scrap metal, clothes hangers or pots & pans. You can place scrap metal out with the bulky collection.

- **GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS:**

(clear and colored)



- ✓ Rinse clean.
- ✓ Throw away lids.
- ✓ Labels need not be removed.
- ✓ **NO** window glass, ceramic dishes, light bulbs, drinking glasses.

- Plastic Bottles (**Coded #1 or #2 on Bottom**) examples include:

- ✓ #1 – Soda bottles, some cooking oils, dish detergent and shampoo bottles.
- ✓ #2 – Milk, water, juice jugs, some laundry detergent & fabric softener bottles.
- ✓ Rinse, flatten and throw away caps.
- ✓ **NO** motor oil, anti-freeze, or pesticide bottles.
- ✓ **NO** other plastics coded with 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7.
- ✓ **NO** deli containers, yogurt or margarine tubs.
- ✓ **NO** PLASTIC BAGS.

- ✓ **DO NOT** replace caps on empty plastic bottles.

**Paper must be bundled or bagged and placed on top of the bin.**

- **NEWSPAPERS**

- ✓ Place in paper bags or tie securely with string.
- ✓ Put on top of bin



- **GLOSSY MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, HOUSEHOLD MAIL & WRITING PAPER**

- ✓ Bundle together in closed paper bags separate from newspapers. Put a second paper bag over the open end of the first one to prevent blowing.

- **PHONE BOOKS**

- ✓ Place on top of bin

- **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD**

- ✓ Unwaxed, clean with “waffle core”.
- ✓ Flatten and cut.
- ✓ Place inside or bundle beside bin.
- ✓ **NO** beverage cartons, no cereal or no pizza boxes and no waxed cardboard.

**USE THE BROWN CART FOR DAILY GARBAGE:**

- **MIXED TRASH:** plastic wrap, plastic bags, broken toys, ceramics, foil, light bulbs & other loose garbage.

- **BAGGED GARBAGE:** food waste, sawdust, vacuumings, polystyrene, cool ashes, etc.

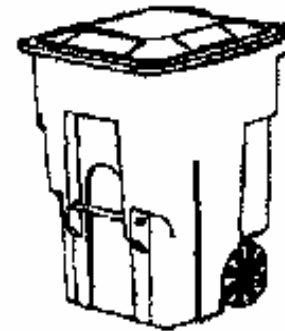
**DO NOT INCLUDE IN GARBAGE:**

- yardwaste
- recyclables
