**SPRING / FALL BRUSH AND
BAGGED LEAF PICK-UP - 2010**

Brush and bagged leaves must be curbside and next to the driveway by 7 a.m. on the following days. Each household is limited to one 4 x 4 x 5 brush pile.

May 3rd October 25th November 15th

**CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP:
JANUARY 11, 2010**

Trees must be curbside next to your driveway at 7 a.m. and be free of snow, bags, decorations, lights and tree stands.

Wreaths go with the regular garbage.

PAPER PRODUCTS

ACCEPTABLE:

Newspapers & Inserts
Magazines & Books
Office Paper, any color
Corrugated Cardboard
Non-Corrugated Cardboard (cereal boxes, soda boxes, etc.)

Paper Grocery Bags
Envelopes
Junk Mail, Catalogs
Phone Books

NON-RECYCLABLE:

Tissue Products
Paper Towels
Paper Contaminated w/ Food Residue or Other Debris

Dairy Carton Boxes
Frozen Food Boxes

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Corrugated boxes are to be flattened, cut to 3' x 3' size and bundled
Paper products may be placed in brown paper bags and placed on top of your recycling container to help prevent litter.
Please remove plastic food liners from boxes.

PLASTIC

ACCEPTABLE:

Plastic #1: PETE, PET: soda bottles
Plastic #2: HDPE: milk jugs, empty oil & anti-freeze
Plastic #3: PVC, V: detergent bottles
Plastic #4: LDPE: lids from tubs or coffee cans
Plastic #5: PP: syrup bottles
Plastic #6: PS: vitamin bottles
Plastic #7: OTHER: ketchup bottles

NON-RECYCLABLE:

Plastic Toys
Plastic Bags
Medical Supplies
Styrofoam Or Microwave Containers
Pesticide Or Herbicide Containers

Flower Pots
Garden Plastic

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please rinse containers.

Make sure container is labeled 1 through 7 on the bottom.

Note: It is not necessary to remove labels or caps.

GLASS

ACCEPTABLE:

Any Color Glass Bottles, Jugs Or Jars
Glass Beverage Or Food Containers

NON-RECYCLABLE:

Drinking Glasses Or Crystal
Window Or Auto Glass
Ceramic Items (Dishes, Vases, Cups)

Light Bulbs

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please rinse containers.

Recycle clear, green, brown and tinted glass.

Note: It is not necessary to remove labels or caps.

CANS

ACCEPTABLE:

All Aluminum Cans
All Steel Or Bi-Metal Cans
Metal Lids And Bottle Caps
Empty Aerosol Cans
Clean Aluminum Foil, Trays And Pie Pans
Pots And Pans
Scrap Metal

NON-RECYCLABLE:

Paint Cans with paint inside
Nails and screws
Wire Clothes Hangers

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please rinse all cans.

Note: It is not necessary to remove labels or caps.

Non-Recyclable Items
