* New Garbage and Recycling Carts

Each home will receive 2-96 gallon carts free of charge. One Brown (Garbage only) and one Green (Recycling only).

* Garbage is collected weekly

All material must fit in the brown (garbage) cart. Automated trucks cannot pick up any material that is next to the cart.

Please put the garbage cart out the night before your collection day or by 6:00 a.m. the morning of pick up.

* Recycle is collected every other week

Loose recycling must fit in the green (recycle) cart. Automated trucks cannot pick up any material that is next to the cart. **Please put the recycle cart out the night before your collection day or by 6:00 a.m. the morning of pick up. If your green recycle cart is out on the wrong week it cannot be collected!**

* Bulk items are collected once a month

Per City ordinances, bulk items should not be placed at the curb prior to 6 p.m. the night before your bulk collection day. Please see the collection calendar for your bulk pick up day. This day is for any extra garbage or recycling you have or items that are too big to fit in the carts.

This does not include yardwaste, construction material or hazardous material.

Place all large items including furniture, carpeting, large metal, large cardboard boxes (emptied and flattened) and appliances at the curb. Small items such as automotive batteries, tires (2 per home per month) drain oil (in sealed 1-5 gallon containers) can also be placed at the curb. Extra paper or bulk recycling should be bagged in clear plastic bags.

Please note that the green recycling carts are emptied every other week and cannot be emptied by the bulk collection crews.

**BROWN CART
(GARBAGE)
EVERY WEEK**

**PLEASE PLACE IN THE
BROWN CART:**

• MIXED TRASH

Plastic wrap, bags, broken toys,
ceramics, light bulbs etc.

• BAGGED GARBAGE

Food waste, styrofoam,
other loose trash, etc.

**DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING
ITEMS IN THE BROWN CART**

-yard waste
-recyclables

-household hazardous waste
-cardboard boxes
-construction materials

Please put bagged trash in the brown cart.

Bags that are tied keep the carts clean.

Loose garbage can be put in the brown cart.

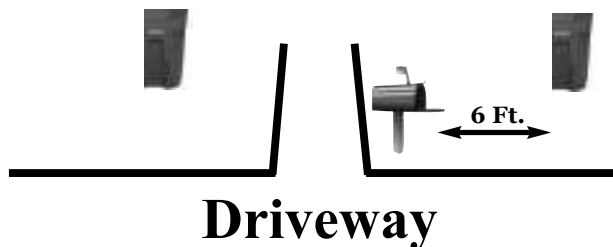
Driver does not get out of the truck.

**CURBSIDE CART
LOCATION
(THE ARROWS ON THE LID
OF THE CART MUST POINT
TO THE ROAD)**

The garbage cart should be
placed within 2 ft. of the
curb on one side of the driveway.

The recycle cart should be
placed within 2 ft of the curb
on the other side of the driveway.

**Please keep 6 ft. of clearance
between the carts and other
objects, especially mailboxes,
vehicles and bulk items.**



**GREEN CART
(RECYCLE)
EVERY OTHER WEEK**

**PLEASE PLACE IN THE
GREEN CART:**

• MIXED CONTAINERS

Aluminum foil, tin cans, steel cans,
aerosol cans, dried out paint cans,
glass bottles/jars, and #1-2 plastic
bottles or jugs. Please only recycle
plastic items with threaded tops.
No plastic except plastic bottles.

• MIXED PAPER

Newspapers, magazines, books, mail,
school/office paper, brown corrugated
cardboard, gray chipboard (cereal and
shoe boxes) & brown bags.

• SHREDDED PAPER

Please put in a clear plastic bag, tied,
and place in the GREEN cart. No
other recycling should be put in bags.

**DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING
ITEMS IN THE GREEN CART**

-plastic bags
-toys
- styrofoam of any kind
-other plastic
-yard waste
-trash
-household hazardous waste
-construction materials

*Do not put recycling in plastic bags.
(See exception for shredded paper)*
