Located at 4551 S 52nd St. City of Greenfield
Drop offs at the 52nd St. location are free to Greenfield residents.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Tuesday & Thursday 3:00 pm - 7:00 pm

Saturday 7:30 am - 3:30 pm

Closed on Federal Holidays

- Proof of Residency is Required (Must have ID)
- Load size is limited/equal to one full size pick up truck per day.

ITEMS ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- Refuse/Garbage/Trash
- Recyclables (*empty/flatten all cardboard boxes, place other loose recycling in easy to empty containers or paper bags*)
- Yard waste (*same rules for curbside pick up apply to drop off locations; see details below*)
- Antifreeze/Automotive Oil/ Oil Filters/ Absorbents
- Residential & automotive batteries
- Electronics
- Appliances (*including Freon*) & other scrap metal
- Tires (*can be on or off rim, up to 4 per day*)
- All types of residential use light bulbs

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

YARD WASTE

- Brush must be less than 6" diameter, bundled in 4' sections.
- Place clippings/leaves/garden debris in marked reusable containers or compostable bags, **NOT** in plastic bags.
- Place properly contained yard waste at curb away from garbage and recycle carts.
- Curbside pickup will be bi-weekly on recycle pick up week from April - November.

CHRISTMAS TREES:

- Trees will be picked up curbside, must be out by 6 AM, Monday, January 9th, 2012.
- Trees may be dropped off at the 52nd Street location.

LARGE ITEMS

- Each residence is allowed 2 special pick ups per year for no additional fee.
- Additional picks are available for a nominal charge, call Johns Disposal to schedule.

BROWN CART GARBAGE EVERY WEEK

PLEASE PLACE IN THE BROWN CART:

MIXED TRASH

- Plastic wrap
- Plastic bags
- Broken toys
- Ceramics
- Bagged garbage
- Light bulbs
- Food waste
- Styrofoam
- Other loose trash

*Please put bagged trash in the brown cart.
Bags that are tied keep the carts clean.*

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE BROWN CART

- Yard waste
- Recyclables
- Household hazardous waste
- Cardboard boxes
- Large construction materials
- Electronics

City of Greenfield drop off center provides alternative options for many of these items. See drop off center information.

CART PLACEMENT

The arrows on the lid of the cart must point to the street.

Handles and wheels should face away from the street.

The garbage cart should be placed within **2 ft.** of the street on one side of the driveway.

The recycle cart should be placed within **2 ft.** of the street on the other side of the driveway.

Please keep **6 ft.** of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles.

PLEASE PLACE IN THE GREEN CART

MIXED CONTAINERS

- Aluminum cans & clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/ dried paint cans
- Glass bottles, jars
- #1-7 plastics
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Books
- Mail
- School/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard (flattened)
- Gray chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.)
- Brown paper bags

SHREDDED PAPER

Please put in a secured clear plastic or paper bag, and place in the GREEN cart. NO other recycling should be placed in bags.

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE GREEN CART

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Yard waste
- Trash
- Household hazardous waste
- Construction materials
- Drinking glasses
- Clothing
- Window glass or ceramic items
- Light bulbs

All recycling should be placed loose into the carts. Please do not put recycling in plastic bags.
