GARBAGE

EVERY WEEK

PLEASE PLACE IN GARBAGE MIXED TRASH

- Plastic wrap
- Plastic bags
- Broken toys
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs
- Bagged garbage
- Food waste
- Styrofoam
- Other loose trash

ACCEPTABLE LARGE ITEMS

Collected Each Week

- Furniture
- Carpeting (no wider than 4ft and rolled)
- Extra garbage bags outside cans
- Large metal items
- Appliances
- Tires (2 per home per month - 8 per year)
- Humidifiers/de-humidifiers, water softeners
- Air conditioners
- Box springs & mattresses
- Earth, rocks, concrete, loose construction materials if contained in (32) gallon cans or less that weigh (60) pounds or less

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OUT FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION

- Yard waste
- Recyclables
- Household hazardous waste
- Cardboard boxes

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Garbage cans must be no larger than 40 gallons.
- Please place garbage and recycling within 2 feet of the curb and 6 feet apart, recycle cart lid arrow facing the road.
- Please place garbage/recycling at the curb the night before service or by 6 AM on your day of service.
- The recycle cart is for "single stream" recycling. All recycle items are to be placed loose in the recycle cart, no sorting or bagging is necessary on your recycle collection day (except shredded paper).
- Large garbage items will be collected weekly on your normal day of service; extra recycling material will be collected on your recycling week only.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Yard waste
- Hazardous materials & liquid paint
- Electronics
- Loose bulk construction materials

PLEASE PLACE IN RECYCLE CART

MIXED CONTAINERS

- Aluminum cans & clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, dried /empty paint cans, small scrap metal.
- Glass bottles, jars
- #1-7 plastic
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Books
- Mail
- School/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard (flattened)
- Gray chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags

SHREDDED PAPER

Please put in a secured clear plastic bag, and place in the recycling cart.

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE GREEN RECYCLE CART

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Yard waste
- Trash
- Household hazardous waste
- Construction materials
- Clothing
