

DROP OFF CENTER

Located at 4551 S. 52nd St. City of Greenfield
Drop offs at the 52nd St. location are free to City of Greenfield residents.

In order to keep the site efficient and fast moving, the following guidelines will be enforced:

- Residency required. City issued barcode card or one-time use pass must be presented.
- Load size is limited/equal to one full size pick up truck per day.
- No loose material in trucks or trailers will be accepted.
- Materials must be in containers that can be easily and quickly emptied by the attendant.
- Yard waste must be placed in easy to empty containers or in compostable bags. (No plastic bags)
- Brush must be less than 8" in diameter and cut down into 4' sections and neatly stacked to allow for quick unload.

ITEMS ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- Refuse/Garbage/Trash
- Recyclables (empty/flatten all cardboard boxes, place all mixed recycling loose in easy to empty containers or paper bags)
- Yard waste (see above guidelines for presentation).
- Antifreeze/ Automotive oil/ Oil filters/ Absorbents
- Automotive batteries
- Electronics
- Appliances (including Freon) and other scrap metal
- Tires (can be on or off rim, up to 4 per day)
- All types of residential use light bulbs (please contain in the box that your new bulbs came in for safe transport)

BROWN CART GARBAGE EVERY WEEK

PLEASE PLACE IN THE BROWN CART

MIXED TRASH

- Plastic wrap
- Plastic bags
- Broken toys
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs
- Bagged garbage
- Food waste
- Styrofoam
- Other loose trash

*Please put bagged trash in the brown cart.
Bags that are tied keep the carts clean.*

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE BROWN CART

- Yard waste
- Recyclables
- Household hazardous waste
- Cardboard boxes
- Construction materials
- Electronics

City of Greenfield drop off center provides alternative options for many of these items. See drop off center information.



CART PLACEMENT

-The arrows on the lid of the cart must point to the street.

-Handles and wheels should face away from the street.

-The garbage cart should be placed within **2ft.** of the street on one side of the driveway.

-The recycle cart should be placed within **2ft.** of the street on the other side of the driveway.

-Please keep **6ft.** of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Yard Waste

-Curbside yard waste pickup is bi-weekly opposite recycle week. This is a seasonal service, see collection calendar for specific dates.

-Brush must be less than 8" in diameter and 4' lengths with cut end to the curb, stacked 4' high and 10' long. Limit of 1 pile per pickup.

-Place clippings/leaves/garden debris in marked reusable containers or compostable bags, not in plastic bags.

-Place properly contained yard waste at curb away from garbage and recycle carts.

Large Items

-Each residence is allowed 2 special pickups per year for no additional fee.

-Additional pickups are available for a fee, contact our office to schedule a collection.

MIXED CONTAINERS

- Aluminum cans
- Clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans
- Steel cans
- Aerosol cans
- Empty/dried paint cans
- Glass bottles, jars
- #1-7 plastic
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Books
- Mail
- School/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags

SHREDDED PAPER

Please put in a secured clear plastic bag, and place in the GREEN cart. No other recycling should be placed in bags.

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE GREEN CART

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Yard waste
- Trash
- Household hazardous waste
- Construction materials
- Electronics
- Clothing
